

# Club Regulations

1. Dress Code  
Any colour of sports shorts, skirts, shirts, jumpers may be worn and sports shoes that don't damage or mark the tennis courts.
2. Cycles, Scooters, Skateboards, Skates  
No riding within the inside grounds and not allowed to be taken beyond the entrance gate.
3. Dogs  
Dogs must be kept on a lead and under control. Owners to clean up if dog fouls. Dogs are not allowed in the clubhouse or on the tennis courts.
4. No Smoking  
Smoking is not allowed in the clubhouse or on the tennis courts.
5. Hours of Use  
Tennis courts may be used from 8am to 10pm daily, clubhouse and grounds to 10.30pm.
6. Waste  
Do not leave litter, cans, bottles, can tops, etc, on the courts or grounds – put it into a waste bin, if one bin full put it into another.
7. Serverybar  
Return crockery and glasses to the Serverybar.
8. Visitors  
Visitors may only play three times in a year and must be accompanied by a Member who will make an appropriate entry in the Visitors Book and pay the fee before going on court – Adults £4 and Juniors £2.50 per occasion. Matches other than in Sussex League (senior or junior), member has to pay the visitor fee.
9. Subscriptions  
Annual Subscriptions are for the period 1<sup>st</sup> April to 31<sup>st</sup> March the following year. Everyone must make sure that they are a fully paid up member before going on court.
10. Parents  
Parents of Juniors & Munchkin Juniors are responsible for their child's behaviour on Club premises. The Club cannot accept any responsibility for unaccompanied juniors.
11. Viewing  
Viewing tennis from anywhere on the surrounding perimeter banks (where there are shrubs planted) is strictly forbidden – a Council Planning Condition.
12. Alcohol Licence  
The Club's Alcohol Licence only permits alcohol drinks to be taken within the Clubhouse and on it's veranda, also on the lawn immediately in front of clubhouse up to pathway leading to gate for Court 7 & 8.
13. Bench Seats & Tables  
Keep well away from grass bank edge.
14. Lock Up.  
When you appear to be the last person on the premises, especially evenings, please turn inside lights off and check clubhouse door has shut tight, also that the grounds entrance gate has shut tight.
15. Club Constitution  
The Club's Constitution is displayed on the clubhouse notice board.
